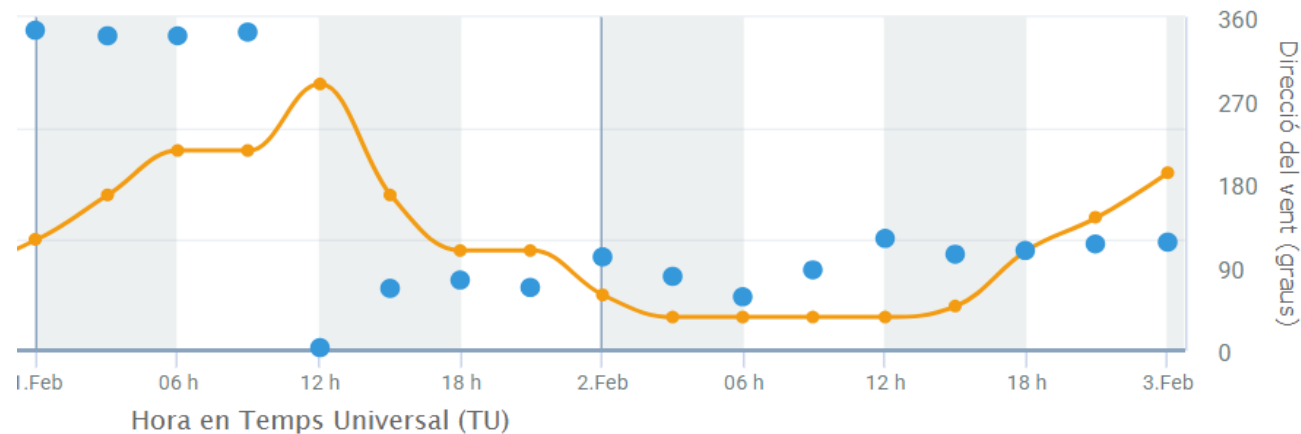

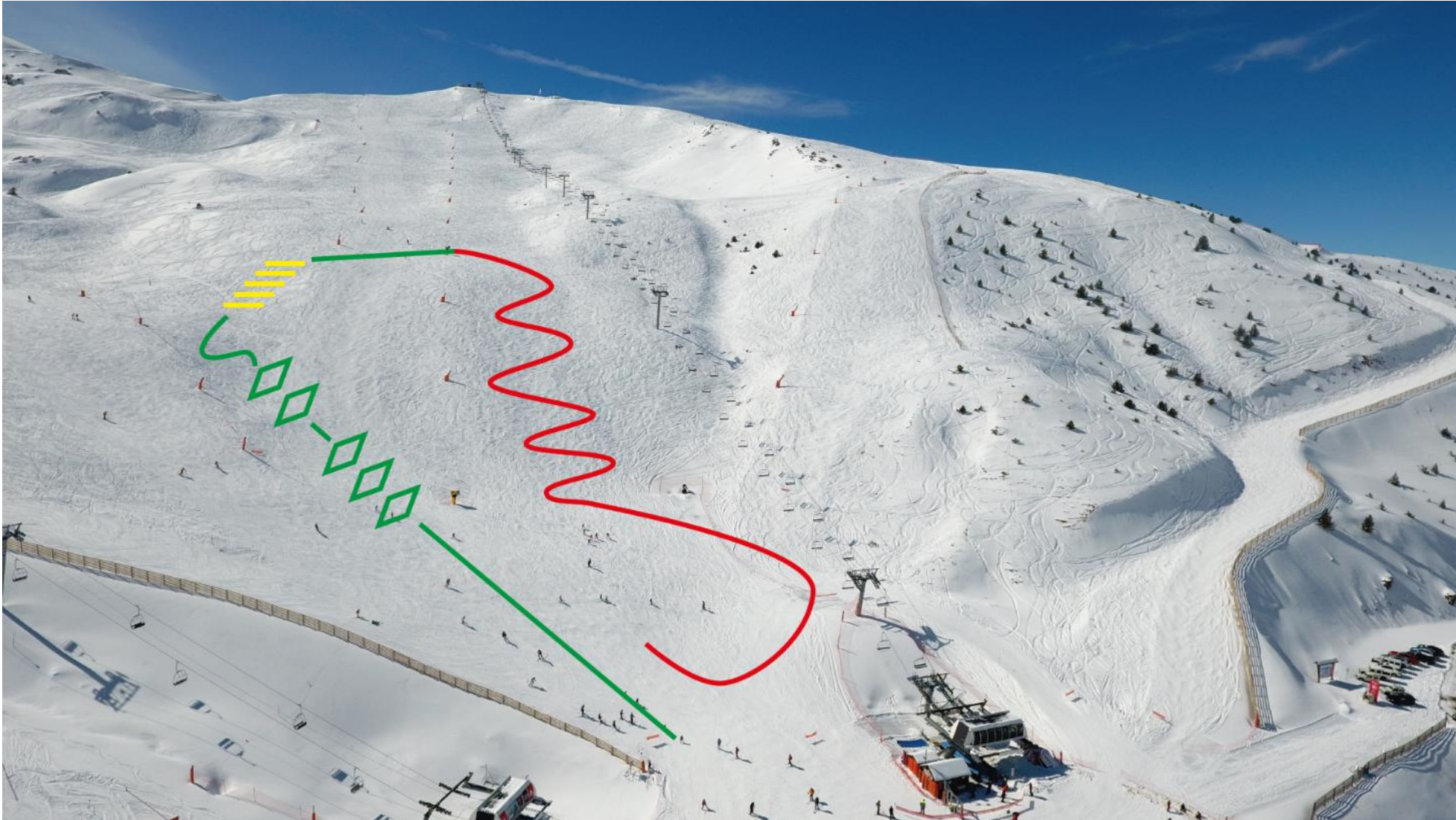

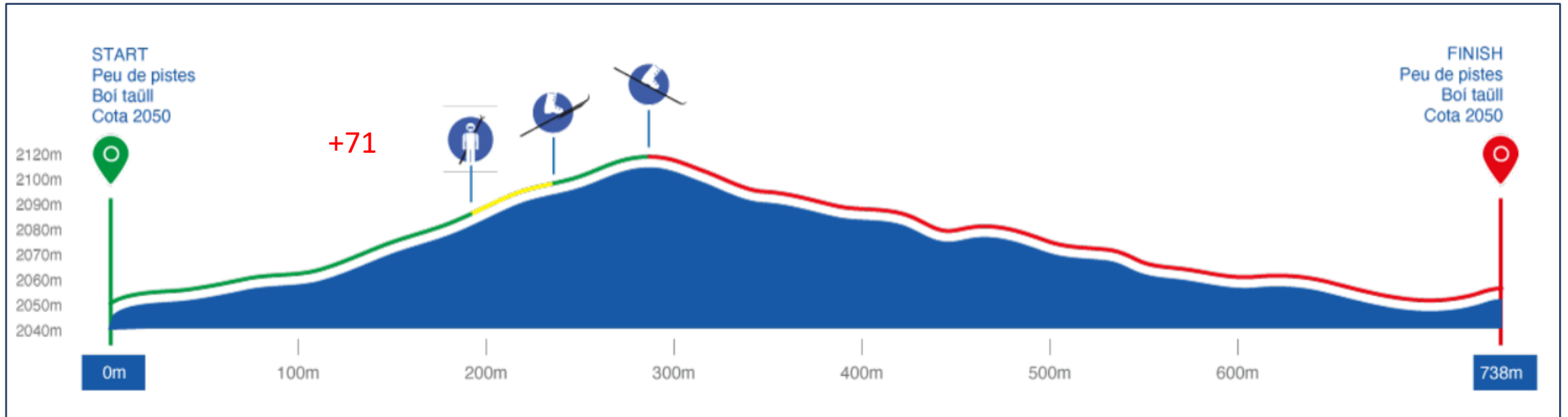
Map and track

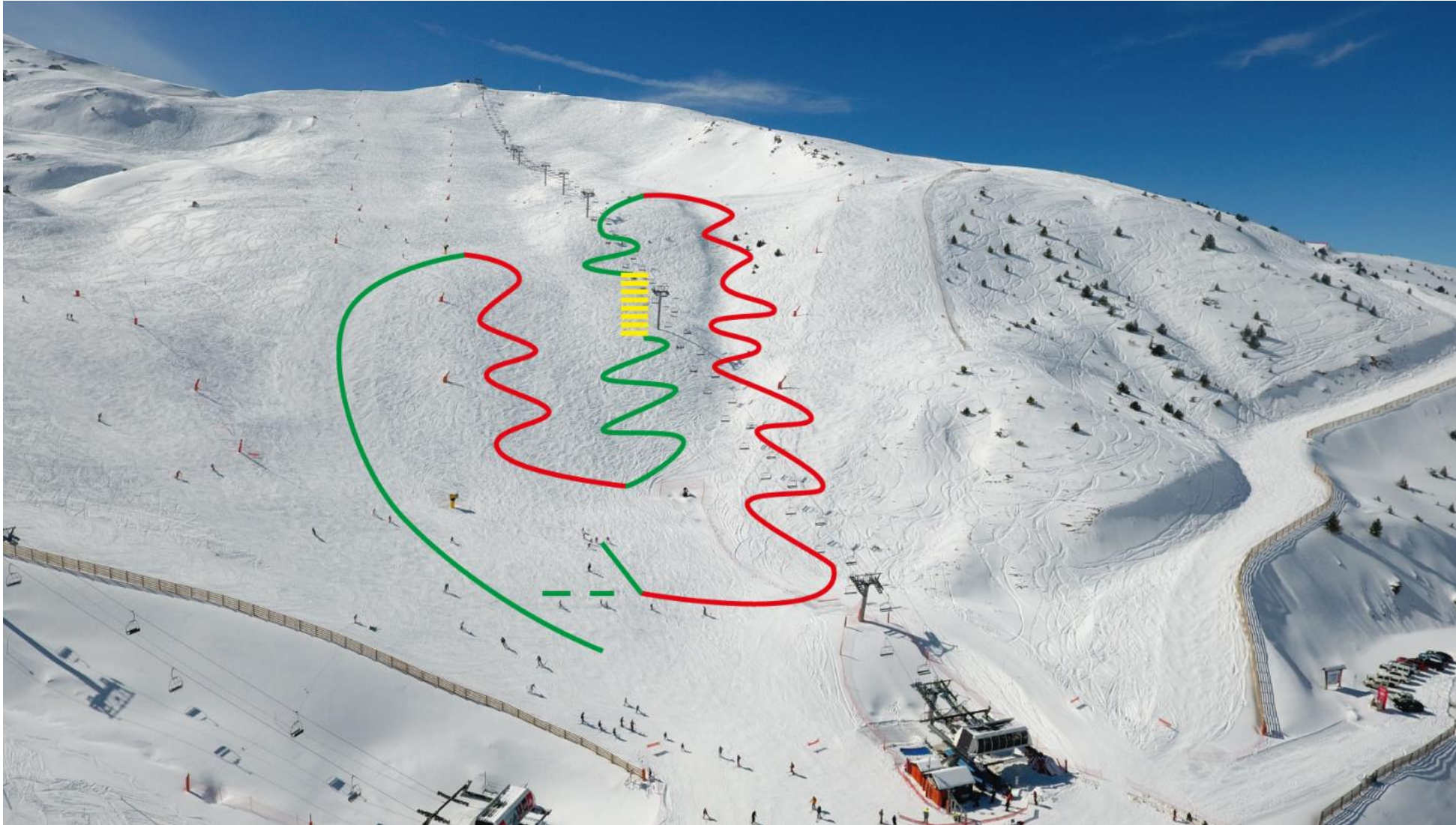

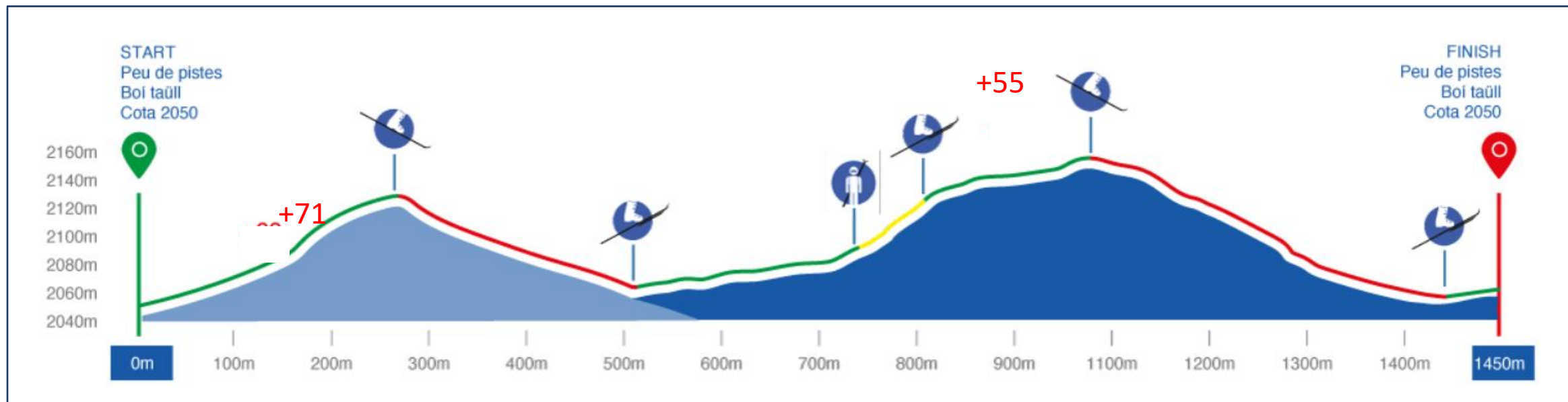
Map and track

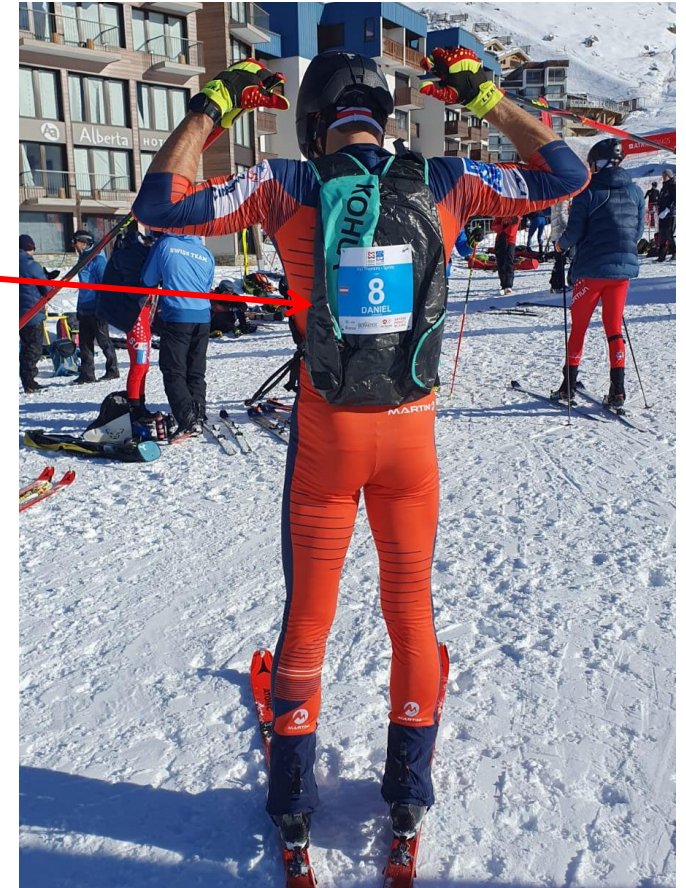
Bib and Transponders position

Parking / Shuttle: THE CLOSEST CAR PARK TO THE COMPETITION AREA IS SIGNED.
 THE ORGANIZATION PROVIDES A BUS SERVICE FOR THE ATHLETES THAT GOES THROUGH ALL THE VILLAGES IN THE VALLEY WHERE THE TEAMS ARE STAYING.
 ALL THE DELEGATIONS HAVE RECEIVED SPECIFIC INFORMATION ABOUT THE BUS SCHEDULE.
 Cable car / chairlift: OPEN AT 9AM
 Team Area: NEAR THE STARTING AREA
 Dressing Room: THERE IS NO DRESSING ROOM
 Warm-Up Area: NEXT TO THE COMPETITION AREA THERE IS A PISTE CALLED GINEBRELL WHERE YOU CAN TRAIN CLIMBS.
 THERE IS NOT MUCH SNOW, BE CAREFUL ON THE DESCENT.
 WE ASK FOR MAXIMUM RESPECT AND CARE FOR THE SKIERS OF THE RESORT.
 Toilets: IN THE SERVICES BUILDING
 Coaches Areas: PARALLEL TO THE CIRCUIT, UP TO SPRINT PLATFORM 3 OR MIXED RELAYS PLATFORM MARKED WITH BLUE TAPE, IT IS RESTRICTED TO ACCREDITED COACHES ONLY.
 THE PUBLIC CAN FOLLOW THE COMPETITION FROM OUTSIDE THE STADIUM, VERY CLOSE BUT ALWAYS BEHIND THE NETTING.
 Media Areas: ACCREDITED PRESS CAN ACCESS THE COACHES' HALLWAY.
 IN THE ARRIVAL AREA, THERE IS ALSO A PRESS AREA WHERE PHOTOS OF THE FINISH LINE AND THE FLOWER CEREMONY CAN BE TAKEN.
 Spectator Areas: THE PUBLIC CAN FOLLOW THE MATCHES CLOSELY BUT ALWAYS OUTSIDE THE STADIUM, ON THE OTHER SIDE OF THE NET.



Case of abandon of an athlete



Abandon:

- An athlete having difficulties may give up on his/her own initiative or be forced to give-up by decision of the LOC Race Director or one of the doctor's present.
- Giving up (by own initiative or forced) must take place at a checkpoint or waypoint according to the procedure described during the TCM except under extreme circumstances. For team races, if one team member gives up then the other will be told to give up and must follow instructions given by the controllers. Every athlete having withdrawn **MUST** inform the ISMF Jury President (or his/her representative) upon arrival at the finish area. The athletes having withdrawn may also be subject to doping control.



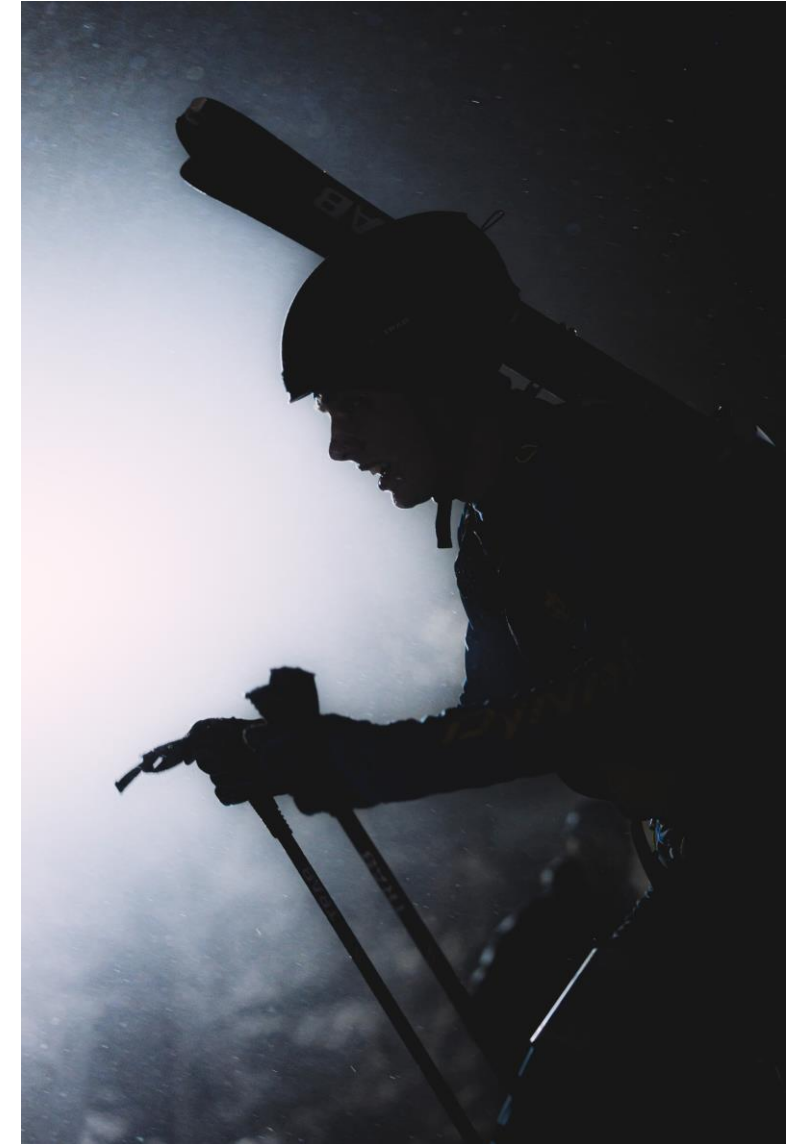

PROTOCOL FOR START LIVE TV 24/25

SPRINT / MIXED RELAY FINAL PRESENTATION

- **Format:** Each athlete will present individually.
- **Procedure:**
 - Walk in front of the camera.
 - Say "hi" and then move to your **left** side.
 - Take your time, be natural, and enjoy the moment.
- **Timing:** Be in the designated area **5 minutes before the start.**

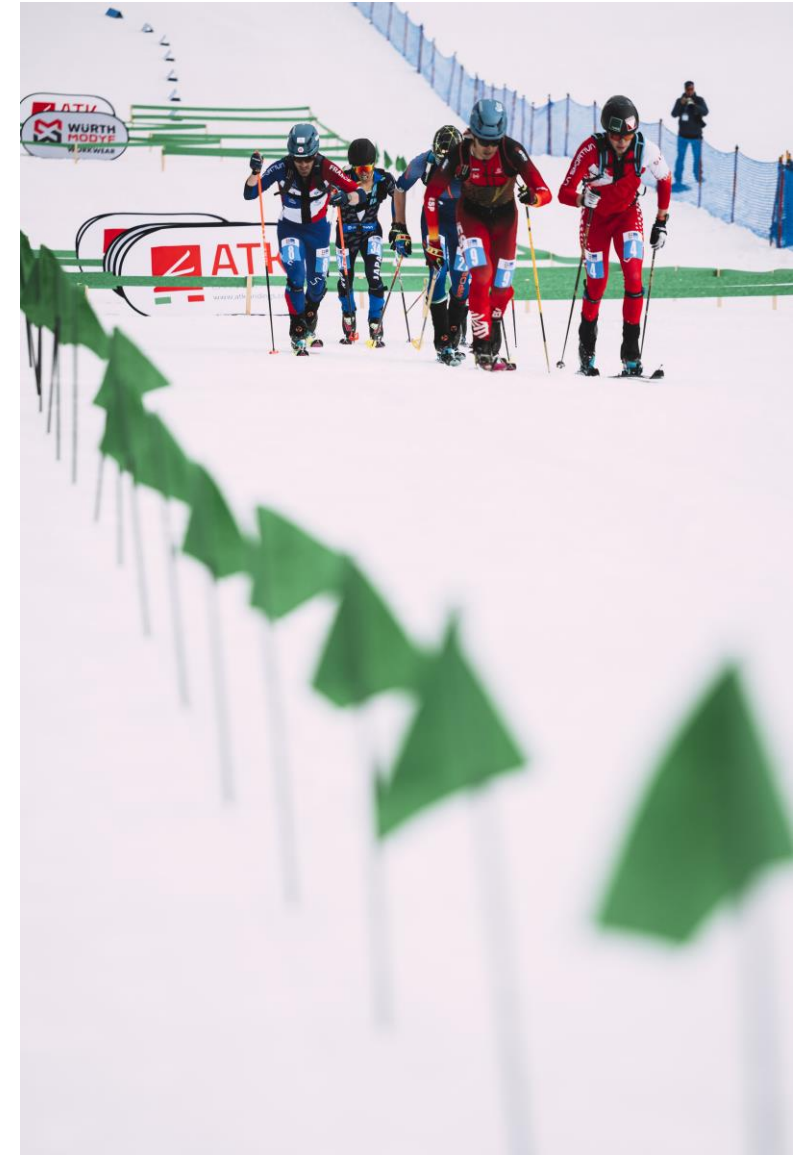
PROTOCOL FOR PODIUM LIVE TV 24/25

ARRIVAL AT THE FINISH LINE

To ensure that interviews and the podium ceremony can be broadcast on linear TV, we kindly ask you to follow the protocol below:

Only For the Top 3 Finishers:

- This year, immediately after the finish, the top 3 winners will proceed to the Backdrop area (3, 2, 1) for photos and filming.
- Do not leave the arrival area after crossing the line.
- The ISMF Media Team will guide you to the **podium celebration**.
- **Podium Protocol:**
 - Only the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place athletes will be called for the podium celebration.
 - Stay ready for an **interview in English**.
- **Note** Please give interviews to other media **only after** completing the podium celebration and the TV interview.

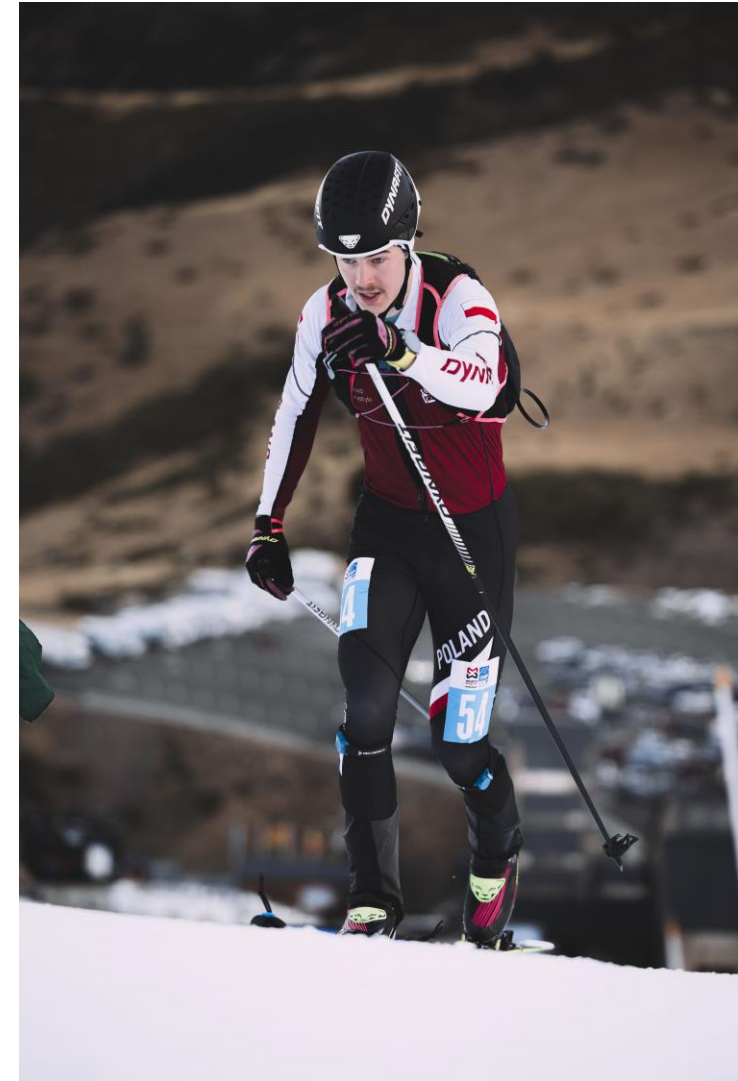

OTHER CONSIDERATIONS

- Timing is crucial, and your cooperation ensures smooth TV coverage.
- The ISMF team will be there to assist and guide you through each step.
- Don't worry, you've got this! Focus on enjoying your moment in the spotlight.
- **For Jackets, Anoraks, and Other Equipment:**
 - Please ask your coach to bring jackets and equipment to the arrival area just after material control.
 - Do not go to the coach area during this time.
- **Flower and Awards Ceremony:**
 - The flower and awards ceremonies will take place after all races for both genders are finished.

BEHAVIOR **FOR MEDIA** DURING EVENT

- Respect media areas and photo assignments.
- Photographers must stay in assigned positions.
- Respect staff, coaches and athletes' work.
- In the mixed zone, allow athletes to reach the podium and TV interviews without disruption. After the podium ceremony, interviews and photos are allowed. We appreciate your cooperation.
- Maintain politeness and diplomacy.
